

**Nova Scotia Agricultural College**  
**Policy for Bicycle, Skateboard, and other Non-motorized Transportation**

Nova Scotia Agricultural College recognizes that safe and courteous use of bicycles, skateboards, scooters, inline skates, and other non-motorized transportation devices is an environmentally friendly way for people to move about the campus. This policy sets forth the rules for use of these modes of transportation on campus to protect pedestrians and university property. Any transportation device with a motor that is not an accommodation for a disability is restricted to the roadways and governed by the Province of Nova Scotia Motor Vehicle Act.

1. Bicycles, skateboards, inline skates, and other non-motorized transportation devices may be used for ground transportation on campus walkways and roadways.
2. People using these devices must follow the rules of the road and must yield to pedestrians at all times.
3. The use of bicycles, skateboards, inline skates, and other non-motorized transportation devices is prohibited in and on all university buildings and structures. This includes, but is not limited to, use on stairs, benches, walls, handrails, and any other physical structure other than a walkway or roadway.
4. Any tricks or maneuvers that may cause property damage or personal injury are strictly prohibited.
5. Students who violate this policy will be subject to the student discipline process. Members of the public who violate this policy may be banned from the NSAC campus.
6. Campus safety and security staff will enforce this policy.
